BASIC PRINCIPLES



INFORMATION

More than two years have passed since the beginning of the "refugee crisis". Nevertheless, this still presents a challenge for many communities. Two new positions have been created by the Verbandsgemeinde Rhein-Mosel to support volunteers in their efforts to help refugees.

The integration support workers Ayse Kilicaslan and Petra Stephan act as contact persons for people with a refugee background, but also provide advice and support to volunteers. Further information can be found at www.vg-rhein-mosel.de.

SUPPORT OFFERS

The integration support workers of the Verbandsgemeinde Rhein-Mosel are available as full-time helpers and advisers especially for the following:

- on first contact
- at the registration to a language course
- at the first school registration
- at handling public agencies & documents
- at the search for a job, a professional training or an internship (supportive help)
- and other topics

In individual cases, they also offer a "visiting support" and assistance in finding an interpreter.

OFFICE HOURS

The integration support worker Petra Stephan is available every Monday from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and the integration support worker Ayse Kilicaslan is available every Friday at the same time as contact person in the Rhein-Mosel associated municipality administration (Verbandsgemeindeverwaltung)

Furthermore it is possible to arrange appointments with the integration support workers within the opening time of the social services office (Sozialamt). It is open on each Monday and Wednesday from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon and from 2:00 to 4:00 p.m. Fridays it is open from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

CONSULTING HOURS

The integration support worker Ayse Kilicaslan offers Wednesdays a consulting hour in the protestant vicarage at changing times. In even calendar weeks it takes place from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. and in odd weeks from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m.

Mrs. Kilicaslan also offers a consulting hour in the administration office in Rhens. It takes place every Thursday: In even calender weeks from 8:00 to 9:00 a.m. and in odd weeks from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m.

The integration support worker Petra Stephan is also available every second Friday in the Burghof in Dieblich from 3:30 to 4:30 p.m. for consultation.
